There are up to £10,000 grants for Mensheds but have to have own bank account and constitution before grant is given. - Planning is now in for 3 x containers to be situated at back of church. Have been offered a Portacabin for use by Menshed and have money in situ for resilience container. Awaiting planning permission - Discussion re grants being applied for, future meeting through Community Council to ascertain which grants are being applied for and what. - BDP Meeting with Alex Geddes to discuss funding - Interested party in putting coffee cart outside church over the weekends, he is looking into a street traders licence.
