Congregational Church - CBCA now own the building - Arrangements are being made for Ray Hyman to move in – need to discuss lease, probable formats online, ask Ed Savage to help with legal requirements. Ray will pay for his own insurance for his equipment and will pay £400 per month rent for the space. - Upkeep of church will probably be apprx 6,000 per year based on costs for the hall £1000 in bank can be used from underspend of legal fees, Peter needs to send a variation request so that the funds can be redirected. Need to buy dividers to section off Ray's shop - Peter has been approached by Paul Hogarth of Symposium re the possibility of placing a coffee cart outside of the building on left hand side on the chuckies, this will provide drinks and edible items for sale. - There will be a need to supply electric to the cart, this has been organised already. Paul Hogarth needs to apply for a vendors licence from the Council, CBCA will also need to supply fridge to keep milk cool.
